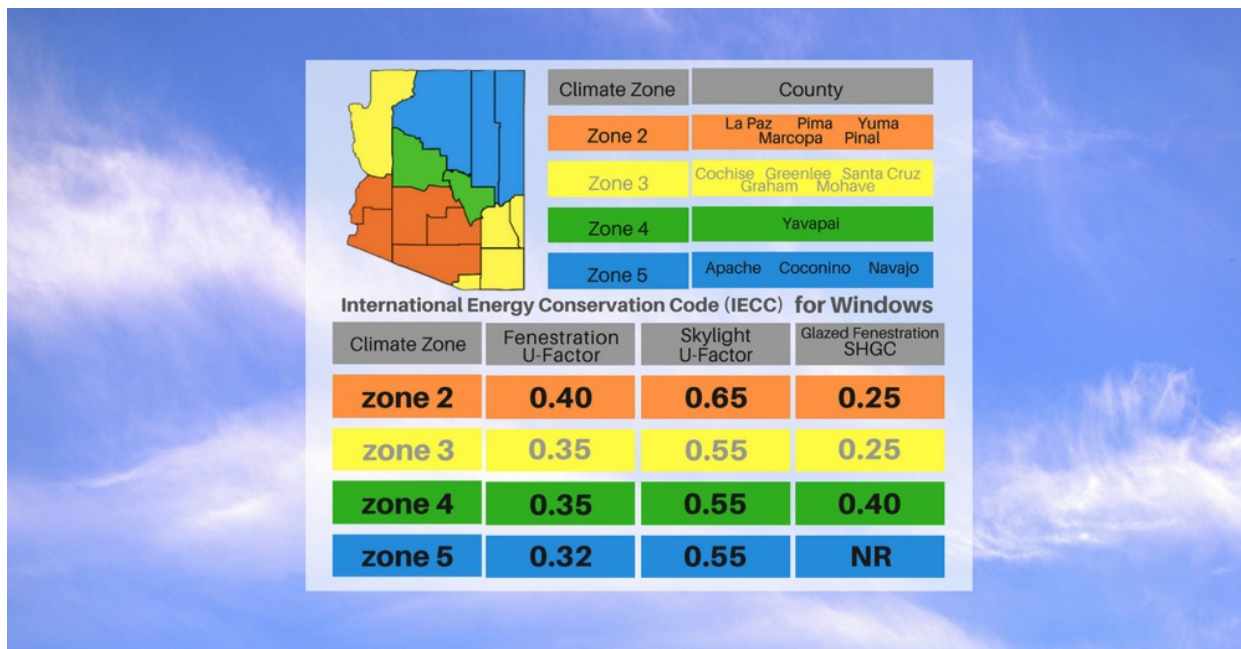
Consider Functionality and Your Needs

The National Fenestration Rating Council (NFRC) provides **certified ratings based on the window's performance criteria** with varying requirements for each distinct US climate zone. **Energy Shield Window and Door Company** adhere to the following **ratings for windows and skylights manufactured for use in the state of Arizona**, as stated in the International Energy Conservation Code (IECC):



- **Fenestration U-Factor** – The U-factor is the actual rate of heat transfer. This rating *shows how well a window or skylight stops the escape of heat* from inside your home.
- **Solar Heat Gain Coefficient (SHGC)** –The SHGC is a rating to *determine increased thermal energy from absorbed solar radiation* through the window.
